1 Overview

1.1 Introduction

The Windcave Drupal Commerce 2.x Module enables merchants with a Drupal 8, 9, or 10 store to accept payments securely via the Windcave payment gateway.

1.2 Features

The Windcave module utilizes a secure Gateway Hosted Payment Page integration method (redirection & iframe) and supports the below transaction types:

- Purchase
- Authorization
- Refund (partial or full refund)
- Complete (full complete)
- Void

Multiple supported Payment Methods:

- Account2Account
- Alipay
- Apple Pay
- Card
- Google Pay
- Interac
- Humm
- PayPal
- Visa Checkout
- Union Pay
- WeChat Pay

Additional features supported by the Windcave module:

- 3D Secure (where supported by acquirer)
- Token creation, storage and re-billing
- Fail Proof Result Notification
- Risk Management
- Address Verification System (AVS)

1.3 Getting Started

To begin using the Windcave Drupal Commerce 2.x Module you will need to meet the below requirements:

1.3.1 Drupal Version

A Drupal version 8, 9, or 10 store. For other Drupal versions please refer to Windcave's other Drupal modules.

1.3.2 Drupal Commerce

Drupal Commerce 2.x module.

1.3.3 Windcave Account

A live or test Windcave account is required to utilize the Windcave Drupal Commerce 2.x module. To setup a new account contact the sales team for a quote - https://www.windcave.com/contact-us.

Merchants with an existing account, visit https://sec.windcave.com/pxmi3/logon and sign in using your Payline credentials. Once signed in select the **User Accounts** → **My User** screen. Your username and Restful API Key will be displayed.



2 Installation & Configuration

2.1 Installation

- 1. Download the module archive file from the Windcave website
- 2. Log in to your Drupal portal using your admin credentials
- 3. From the navigation menu at the top of the page, navigate to Extend



4. Select the + Add new Module button




5. Using the upload function browse to the commerce_windcave zip file downloaded in step 1





6. From the **Extend** page type "Windcave" into the filter search box



7. Select the tick box next to the Commerce Windcave module then select the Install button

2.2 Configuration

- 1. Log in to your Drupal admin portal using your admin credentials.
- 2. From the navigation menu navigate to Commerce -> Configuration -> Payment -> Payment gateways.

- 3. Select the Add payment gateway button.

- 4. Configure your Windcave account settings and preferences:


Setting	Description		
Name	Display name for payment gateway configuration		
Plugin	Plugin integration type, should be set to Windcave HPP to utilize the Windcave Hosted Payment Page		
Display name	Name to be displayed to cardholder when selecting payment method		
API url	The root URL of the Windcave Restful API, this should be set to: https://sec.windcave.com/api/v1		
API username	Windcave Restful API username		
API key	Windcave Restful API key		
Display as popup	Sets if payment window should be displayed as iFrame (Enabled) or redirection (Disabled)		
Popup height	Sets height of the popup iFrame payment window		
Popup width	Sets width of the popup iFrame payment window		
Enable saving cards	If enabled the card holder will be able to save cards and pay using a saved card		
Payment options	Allows the merchant to filter enabled payment options on the Hosted Payment Page Note: Payment options selected must be configured at Windcave on your merchant account to function		
Conditions	Conditions that control when payment gateway option is made available to customer, by default no restrictions are applied		
Status	Enables or Disables module		

5. Once all settings and preferences have been updated click the **Save** button



6. To configure the module for Purchase or Auth payment types navigate to **Commerce -> Configuration -> Orders -> Checkout flows.**

Select Edit on the checkout flow.





Select your chosen transaction mode (Authorize and capture = Purchase, Authorize only = Auth/Complete) and press **Update**.

Transaction mode should be configured for all applicable checkout flows. After updating select the **Save** button at the bottom of the page.






3 Using the Module

3.1 Cardholders


Customers can choose to pay using the Windcave module when they proceed through the checkout. Depending on the merchant's Windcave module configuration a "Purchase" or "Authorisation" will be initiated.





During checkout if **Enable saving cards** module setting is enabled customers may opt to save the payment card for future payments by checking the "Save card for future purchases" checkbox. Alternatively, if the customer already has a saved card this may be selected to process the payment.

Customers can view or delete saved cards by navigating to **My account -> Windcave Saved Cards** once signed into the merchant website.



Windcave saved cards







3.2 Merchants

3.2.1 Processing a Refund


Within the Drupal Commerce admin area merchants can process refunds for orders processed through the Windcave module. To do so merchants simply navigate to the **Commerce -> Orders** page and select the order they wish to refund.




Selecting the **Payments** tab in the order will reveal the payment details processed through the Windcave module. Merchants can then press the **Refund** button to start the refund process.



Then enter the amount they would like to refund (this can be a partial refund or full refund; merchants can refund multiple times up to the total transaction amount) and press the **Refund** button.



The result of the refund transaction will be displayed in the **Windcave transactions** tab of the order.






3.2.2 Completing an Order

Within the Drupal Commerce admin area merchants can complete orders for Auth type transactions processed through the Windcave module. To do so merchants simply navigate to the **Commerce -> Orders** page and select the order they would like to complete.



Selecting the **Payments** tab in the order will reveal the payment details processed through the Windcave module. Merchants can then press the **Capture** button to start the completion process.


Drupal will prompt the merchant to confirm they would like to complete the transaction.

The result of the complete transaction will be displayed in the **Windcave transactions** tab of the order.






3.2.3 Processing Voids

Within the Drupal Commerce admin area merchants can initiate a void for orders where an Auth type transaction was processed through the Windcave module. To do so merchants simply navigate to the **Commerce -> Orders** page and select the order to be voided.



Selecting the **Payments** tab in the order will reveal the payment details processed through the Windcave module. Merchants can then press the **Void** button from the drop-down menu to start the void process.


